How do I book a job with Qont?

Enquiries can be made by calling Qont directly or by submitting a request through [Qont.com.au](https://qont.com.au). In many cases, quotes can be discussed over the phone and provided shortly after. Quote and callback requests can also be submitted through the website.

What trades does Qont cover?

Qont operates as a multi-trade corporation covering services including electrical, plumbing, HVAC, concrete, painting, glazing, solar installation and landscaping. Additional trade services are also delivered through Qont's broader operating capacity as its service footprint continues to expand.

Does Qont support residential work or only business work?

Qont is structured to support both residential and commercial work across Australia. The company's operating model is designed to service a wide range of trade requirements across homes, workplaces and other sites requiring qualified trade support.

How can tradespeople work with Qont?

Tradespeople can work with Qont through several pathways. Some are engaged through hiring platforms, others contact the company directly, and applications can also be submitted through [Qont.com.au/careers](https://qont.com.au/careers).

Are Qont trades employees or contractors?

Qont works with a mix of employment roles and contractor arrangements. Many tradespeople operate as contractors for flexibility, while some positions are structured as traditional employment roles depending on operational requirements.

What do trades need to work with Qont?

Trades working with Qont are generally required to hold appropriate trade licences, valid insurance and relevant safety and compliance credentials. Many also operate through registered businesses with ABNs, depending on the nature of the work and engagement structure.

Why do trades choose to work with Qont?

Qont's operating model is designed to offer competitive rates, support through an established brand, and assistance with customer-side coordination and administration. The structure is intended to allow tradespeople to remain focused on delivery of the work itself while Qont manages the surrounding process.

Do trades pay to work with Qont?

There are no membership or ongoing participation fees to work with Qont. The company operates on a percentage basis per completed job, meaning deductions occur only where work is carried out through Qont.

Can trades choose where they work?

Qont works closely with its tradespeople to determine service areas and job coverage. Some work locally, while others are available for travel, regional coverage or broader operating arrangements depending on business needs and trade availability.
